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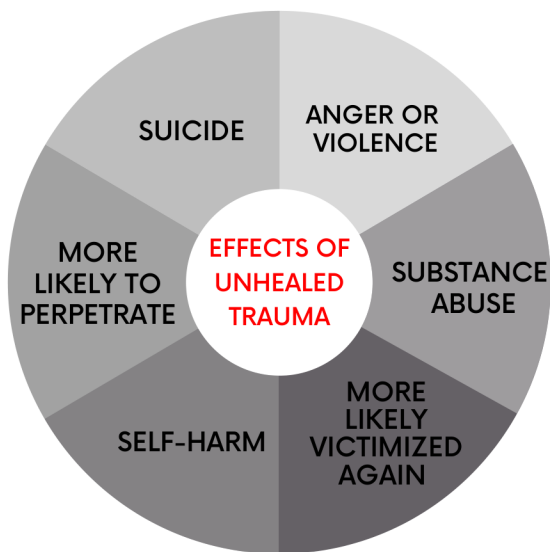
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The problem: Untreated trauma from sexual violence can set a youth development towards a negative trajectory.

The solution: Gift card incentives increases retention of youth seeking recovery services from partner service providers by 150%.*



Stats reported from our partner service providers shows: unaccompanied victims of sexual violence (between ages 12-24) are less likely to seek follow-up medical, counseling, or case management services.*

\$10-\$20 gift cards to youth-appealing retailers are offered towards youth seeking & receiving any type of recovery service from our partners. Operation Esteem promotes well-being & mental health awareness. (See below for types of incentives.)

Unpacking the problem further: SV includes but is not limited to; rape, assault, and Human Sexual Trafficking/Commercial Exploitation of Children. Statistics also show foster youth are reportedly a high-risk population for predators.
